

# 2026 KUSA NATIONAL DOG JUMPING LEAGUE

## IMPORTANT DETAILS

- Grade 1 dogs and Veterans are eligible to enter provided they are registered with KUSA and have valid Record Cards. Veterans are restricted to dogs that compete in the Veterans Class at all shows.
- A handler may be substituted but no dog may be substituted for any round of the KUSA NDJL competition.
- The accumulated scores from the best five (5) rounds for each competing dog will be used to determine the final placings in each height category. The results will be posted on [www.gauteng-agility.co.za](http://www.gauteng-agility.co.za).
- The competition will be run under Table A with a SCT of 3,5 m/s. Veterans will be run under Table B at 2,5 m/s.
- The scoring system is explained in detail in Regulation 7.6 of Schedule 5E (16) which may be downloaded at [www.kusa.co.za](http://www.kusa.co.za).
- A dog may compete in any Province holding a round but will be required to enter as "Not for Competition" if it subsequently enters a show where the same course is being run in another Province. Only the results from the first round will be valid.

## ENTRIES

- The entry fee for the whole competition is R60 per dog.
- This entry fee is in addition to the entry fee levied by the hosting club when the NDJL round is held in conjunction with a KUSA-licensed show.
- Handlers must enter via [www.workingdogs.co.za](http://www.workingdogs.co.za).
- The closing date will be the Monday preceding the first round held in each Province whereafter the entries will be closed.
- Prizes will be funded from the entry fees collected and any sponsorship that may be secured.
- Surplus income generated will be used for the benefit of the Dog Jumping community.
