<b>Course Walking</b>	Handlers are expected to be at their ring when marshalled in order to ensure the timeous running of the individual Shows. This may mean that handlers have to walk more than one course before competing with their dog/s in any/all of the rings. There will only be ONE course walk allowed, if you are competing in a different discipline, please ensure that you make arrangements to attend all the course walks.

The FCI-C.A.C.I.A.G® can only be awarded to exhibits that have been <b>graded “EXCELLENT” with a clear round and upon ratification by FCI.</b></p>																
<p><b>Title of "International Agility Champion" (C.I.A.G.)</b></p>	<p>To attain the “Int. Agility Champion” (C.I.A.G.) (S-M-I-L) title the following requirements need to be met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dog must be registered with a Stud Book recognised by the FCI</li> <li>• Must have earned two (2) FCI-C.A.C.I.A.G® awards in two different countries under 2 different judges over a minimum period of one year and one day.</li> <li>• Must have been awarded a grading of "Good" or better in a Show sanctioned by the FCI.</li> <li>• Every Country will propose to the FCI its candidates for the title of International Agility Champion and will provide the relevant documents.</li> </ul>																

## Please take note of the following:

- Only dogs with a KUSA Registration Number are eligible to enter Shows and those dogs which have been given showing dispensation by the KUSA Office for these Shows.
- **Only Members of the Kennel Union shall be entitled to enter dogs in their registered ownership in any Championship Dog Show licensed by the Kennel Union.**
- Exhibitor numbers can be collected from the Show Office.
- The mating or whelping of bitches within the precincts of the Show venue is forbidden.
- Bitches in season may only be exhibited in Agility and Dog Jumping at all events and exhibitors must exercise due consideration towards other exhibits.
- No animal other than an exhibit entered for competition or exhibition shall be allowed on the grounds, with the exception of registered guide dogs.
- No late entries will be accepted.
- No refunds of entry fees will be made for any errors whatsoever made by the owner/exhibitor/authorised agent.
- All owners/exhibitors/authorised agents/handlers are advised that they and any exhibit entered in any event over the KUSA Classic Weekend may be photographed for, by, or on behalf of KUSA for the use and possible publication of such photograph by KUSA. A special area for the taking of photographs will be provided.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to appoint alternative Judges; re-allocate Classes and advise all exhibits entered; or adjust the judging times prior to the Show, should the appointed Judges be unable to officiate, or receive too large or too small an entry.
- The KUSA website, KUSA Classic 2026 Facebook Page and KUSA Classic 2026 WhatsApp Group are the only communication media officially recognised by the Show Committee.

### The FCI Show is held under the Rules of the FCI, which include the following:

- The dogs' welfare must be of utmost priority at all dog Shows. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that can be dangerous for its health and welfare, such as leaving it in the car in excessively hot or cold weather and/or treating it in a cruel manner. Violation of this rule will result in exclusion from the present and future dog Shows.
  - The FCI Show is judged according to FCI Regulations.
  - Late entries (after the closing date) are not permitted.
  - No transfer by an exhibitor of a dog from one Class to another is permitted after the closing date.
  - If a dog behaves aggressively in the ring and its behaviour is eye-witnessed by the Judge on duty, the latter must submit a report for the attention of the Organising Committee and must disqualify the dog for the rest of the competition. All the awards and titles of the day are consequently cancelled.
  - Where FCI regulations are not covered, then KUSA Schedule 3 shall take effect.
- All the other Shows will be held according to the Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa.
  - Please keep the grounds and bathrooms clean.
  - When exercising your dogs, please clean up after them. Do not leave it for others or the ring stewards to do.

**ALL EXHIBITORS/HANDLERS ARE PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONTROL OF THEIR DOGS AT ALL TIMES AND SHALL BE PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL CLAIMS IN RESPECT OF INJURIES WHICH MAY BE CAUSED BY THEIR DOGS.**

### RIGHT OF ADMISSION RESERVED

Our Right of Admission Reserved is based on our right of "Freedom of Association" as enshrined in Section 18 of the Constitution, insofar as members of the public and even KUSA's own members fail to adhere to the general principles of good order, acceptable behaviour and social decorum customarily required at dog shows. This is likely to include people who are rowdy, drunk, naked, loud or obscene, or who engage in physical violence and/or verbal abuse of other members of the public and of KUSA, or who play loud music or engage in any behaviour that prohibits or limits KUSA and its members from participating in their chosen activity unhindered. In a nutshell, Right of Admission Reserved would sanction the denial of access to, or expulsion from, the premises of persons who indulge in unacceptable conduct and behaviour and who disrupt the good order and social discipline required at dog shows.

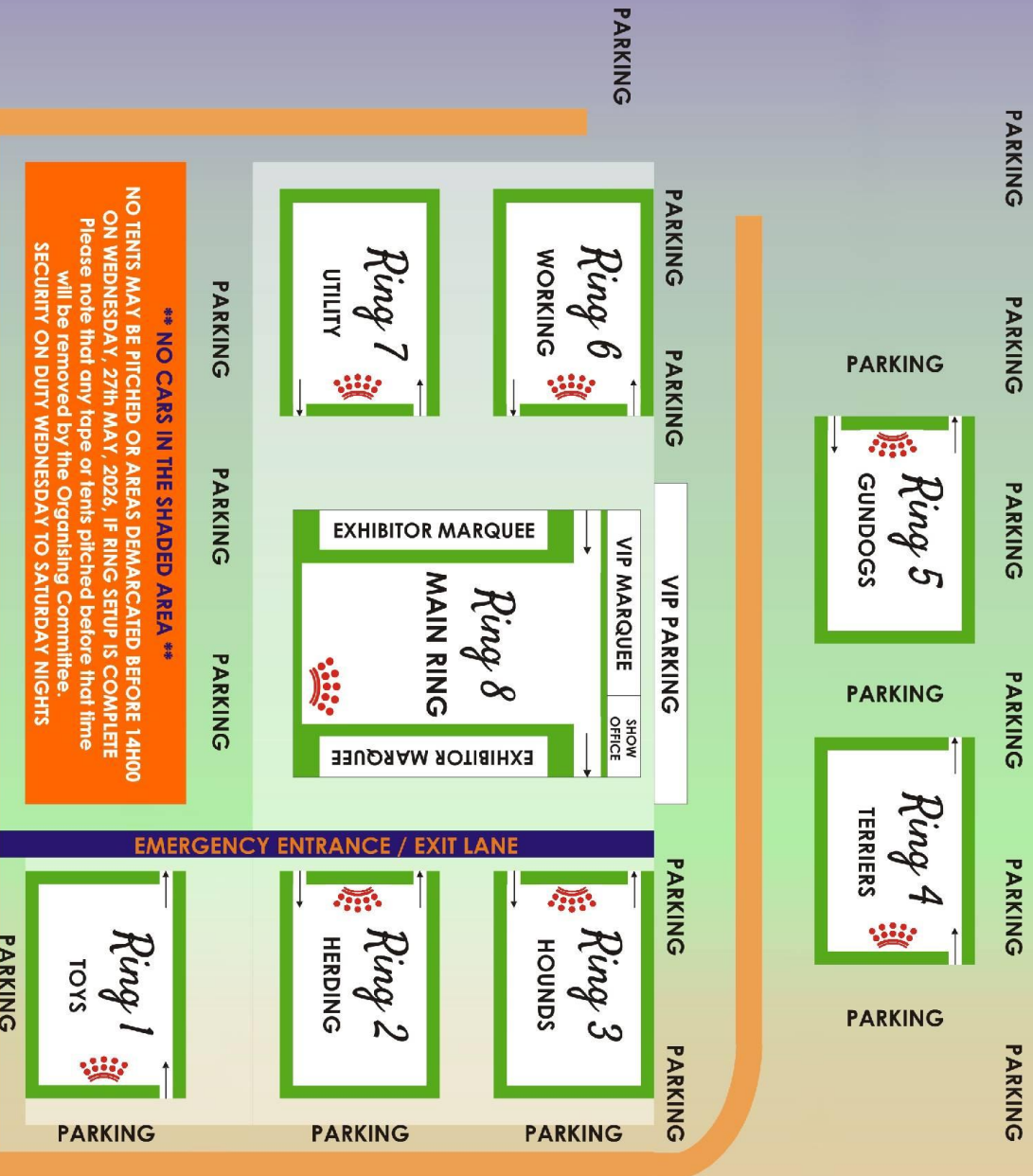

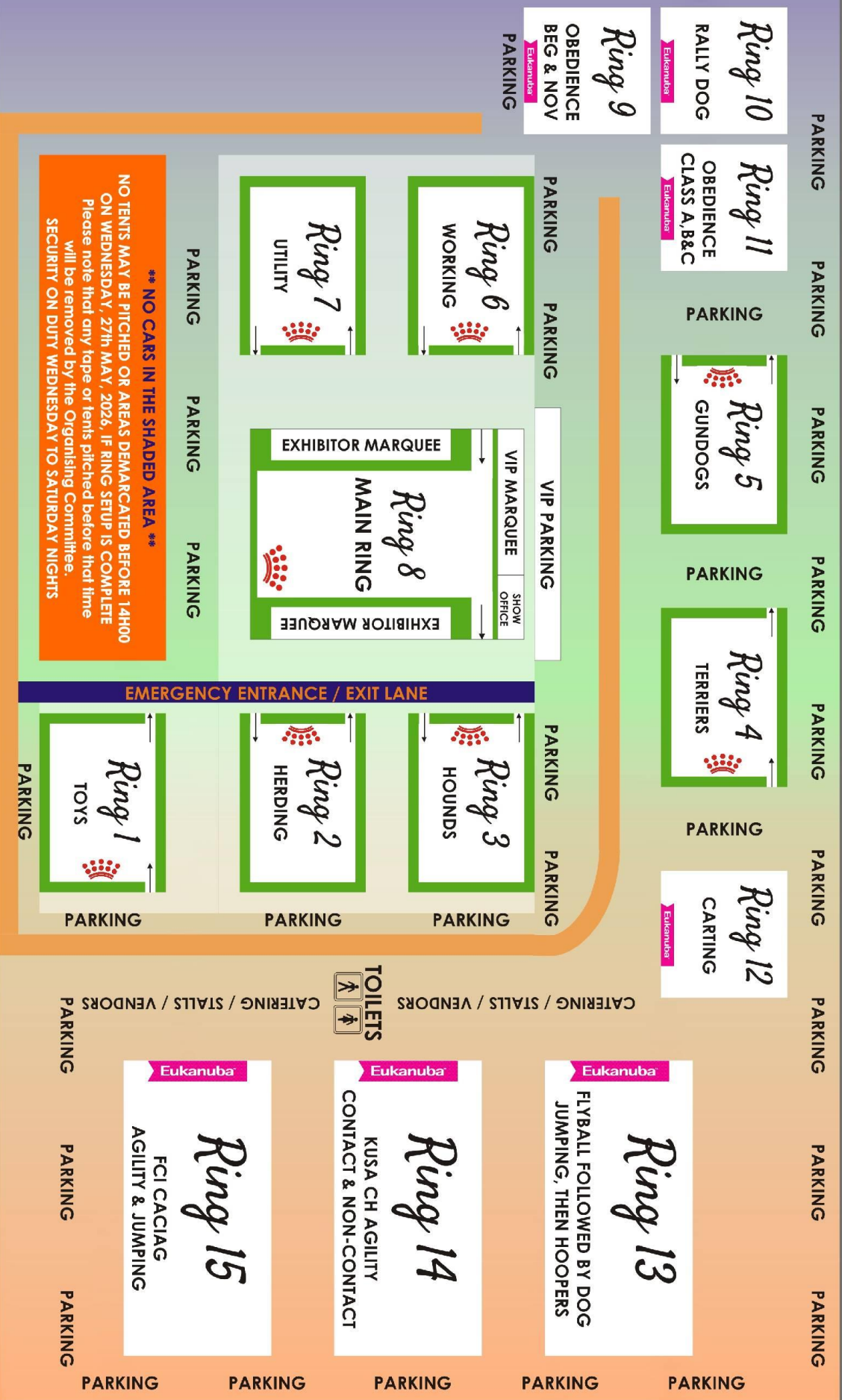
