Bitches in season may only be exhibited in Agility and Dog Jumping and exhibitors must exercise due consideration towards other exhibits. Furthermore, the exhibitors must inform the Show Manager and officiating judge of the bitch's condition before the start of the show. Bitches in season must run last in their respective classes. They must be kept crated and apart from other dogs at the venue. The officiating judge has the authority to expel a bitch in season if her presence causes too much disturbance or attracts the attention of male dogs to a disruptive degree.

All Handlers are personally responsible for the control of their dogs at all times and shall be personally liable for any claims which may be made in respect of injuries which may arise or be caused by their dogs.
