- No RAF or TAF dogs will be accepted. Any incomplete or illegible entries, or those unaccompanied by the correct fees, will be returned. Any dog entered incorrectly will automatically be entered in the Open Class. No changes will be made at the Show.
- No Refunds will be issued on entries
- **CLUBS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO CLOSE ENTRIES EARLY SHOULD MAXIMUM CAPACITY BE REACHED.**
- This show is held under the Rules & Regulations of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa.
- All exhibitors are always personally responsible for the control of their dogs and shall be personally liable for any claims which may be made in respect of injuries which may arise or be caused by their dogs.
- All dogs must be on a lead at all times, unless otherwise instructed by the Judge.
- When your dog poops, pick it up and dispose in bins around the rings – Thank you.

VITTORIO PAPAVERO



My name is Vittorio Papavero and I live in Bracciano, near Rome, with my family where our life is completely centered around dogs. We run two dog training centers, a kennel "Rokitassun," where we breed Shetland Sheepdogs and working Tervurens, and we also organize several agility events each year, from small local competitions to large international events such as the Rome Agility Festival and the ProsecCup in Treviso.

My dog-related adventure began in 1991. I have been part of the Italian agility team more than ten times, with five dogs of four different breeds: Dobermans (AWC 1996 team vice-champion), two Border Collies, a Cocker Spaniel and a Tervuren. My Tervuren won the FMBB World Championship. From 2015 to 2017, I was proudly chosen as team leader for EO and AWC. In 2015, I was also the team leader of the junior national team.

Over the years, I have been a member of the ENCI technical commissions for agility, obedience, and flyball, and a member of the ENCI examination commission for new judges. From the beginning, I have had a great passion for designing and building agility courses, but it was only in 2015 that I decided to become a judge. I have had the honor of being invited to judge throughout Europe, the United States, and South America.

Naturally, the most precious invitation so far was judging the AWC last year (Sweden), but also the Americas & Caribbean Agility Championship (2025 Chile), the Nordic Agility Championship (Denmark), and the FMBB (2022 Greece), an event to which I am deeply attached, being a former world champion and a Tervuren breeder.
